### Purpose

To provide a kerbside hard waste collection for residents and non profit organisations (Church groups, sporting clubs, rotary clubs etc) within the Berri Barmera Council area, being Berri and Barmera townships. Glossop, Monash, Cobdogla, Winkie and Overland Corner and Loveday (Rural residents) are to be provided with a free disposal of hard waste (up to 1, 6x4, trailer load, upon presentation of rate notice at disposal facility).

### Principles

That Council consider providing a kerbside hard waste collection during budget considerations with intent to assist residents and local non-profit organisations in the removal of hard waste. This service can be provided in conjunction with other organisations and industry bodies.

Notification of dates and acceptable items are to be advertised in the local media, via Councils website and social media platforms.
