Purpose

That Council provide, if necessary, plant and equipment to local Emergency Groups as part of a community service.

Principles

In the event of an emergency or disaster within the Council area, that machinery be made available with the consent of the Chief Executive Officer and/or Manager of Infrastructure Services.

Country Fire Service - Use of Council Plant

Council equipment and plant, accompanied with Council operators, may be used within, or outside the Council District for fire fighting purposes with the prior approval of the Chief Executive Officer or Manager of Infrastructure Services. Hire charges may apply.

In the absence of the Chief Executive Officer and Manager of Infrastructure Services, a telephone call to either will be necessary to gain final approval.

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
