Purpose

That in the event of additional plaques being added to the structure in the future, those plaques be constructed in accordance to the conditions as listed below.

Principles

- (1) That the group that wishes to place a plaque must have returned from an Australian Gazetted area of Conflict (i.e. entitled to a “Returned from Active Service Badge.
- (2) Future groups need to be granted permission from the Riverland Vietnam Veterans Association, Berri Barmera Council or the local RSL.
- (3) Plaques are to be of the same size and character as those that are already in place. (The originals were purchased from Riverland Memorials, Hughes Street, Berri)

Organisers of ceremonies relating to particular conflict (or future ones), need to liaise with the Berri Barmera Council. Use of the Memorial is to be encouraged.
